




Our Footprint

Energy

- Linked with <u>CSE</u> in Bristol and NEA to train volunteers
- Link with <u>Evolve</u> to promote free and discounted insulation
- Open Homes events
- Lend thermal imaging camera to residents
- Annual Improve Don't Move and green directory







Energy

- Supported <u>Frome Renewable Energy Co-op</u> to install 200kw of solar
- Solar streets discounted solar offer
- Free solar for business working with **Green Nation**
- Energy sparks helping schools reduce energy
- Lobbying Somerset District Council to divest their pension fund





Energy – next steps

- Understand our housing stock and explore retrofit opportunities
- Saxonvale community owned microgrid and zero carbon heat network
- Train energy champions
- Explore innovative energy models



Transport

- Annual school <u>Active Travel</u> <u>Challenge</u> with 2000 pupils.
- Electric bike hire
- Five free electric charge points installed via **Zero Carbon World**
- Linking with <u>Book My Charge</u> to enable domestic charge points to be shared
- Enabled Co-Wheels to provide shared hybrid vehicles



Transport – next steps

- Map safe walking and cycling routes, mobility patterns and deliveries
- Increase use of Critchill Bike Workshop
- Expand <u>Active Travel Challenge</u>
- Enable long term borrowing of electric bikes
- Link with <u>Book My Charge</u> to enable domestic electric charge points to be shared

£900,000 secured in five years through external grants and community shares. Climate Action Fund – partnership with Medical Practice




Whatcombe fields, 32 acres saved by the local community using community shares
